What's the sharpest, finest-grained film available in 35mm cassettes? Technical Pan film 2415 from Kodak. Tech Pan, when processed in a low-contrast developer like Kodak's Technidol or Perfection XR-2 developer, provides extremely sharp, virtually grainless continuous-tone images that can be blown up into huge enlargements (assuming that you've done all you can to maintain the film's amazing sharpness—mount the camera on a tripod, use a cable release or self-timer to trip the shutter, focus carefully, use a really sharp lens at its sharpest aperture, and lock the camera's mirror up if possible).
